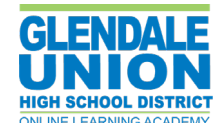

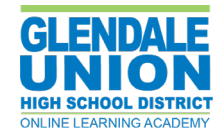

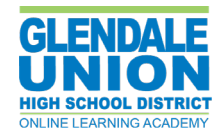


2018 Classroom Spending Analysis

Percentage On Administration

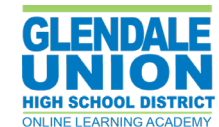
- GUHSD spends less on administration than its peer group

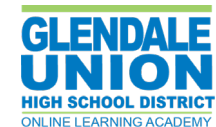
Glendale Union High School District Achievements 2018-2019
