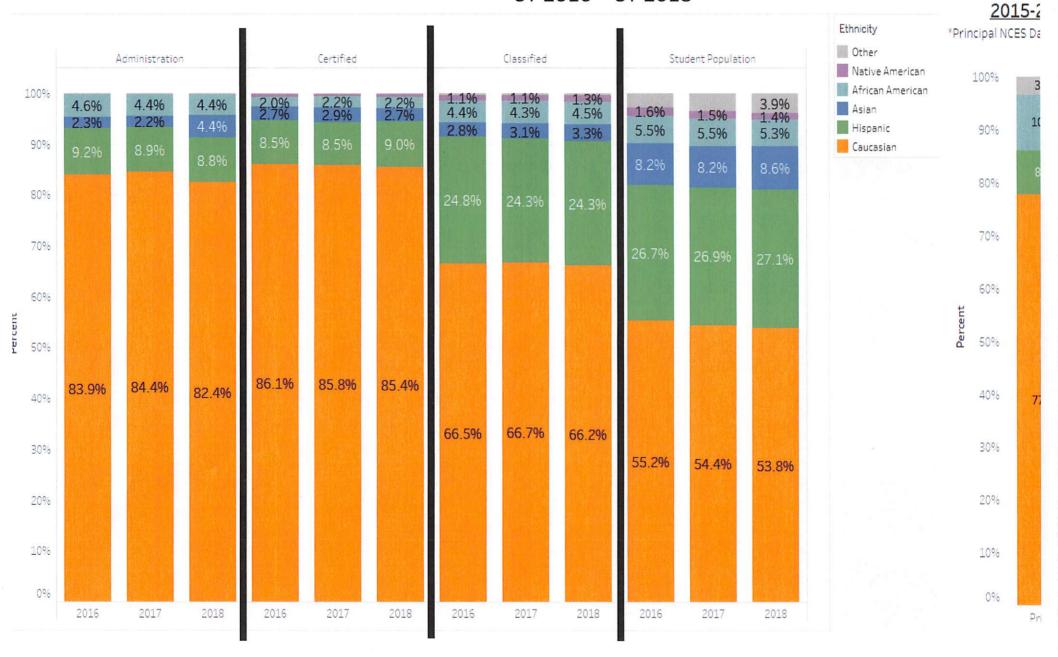




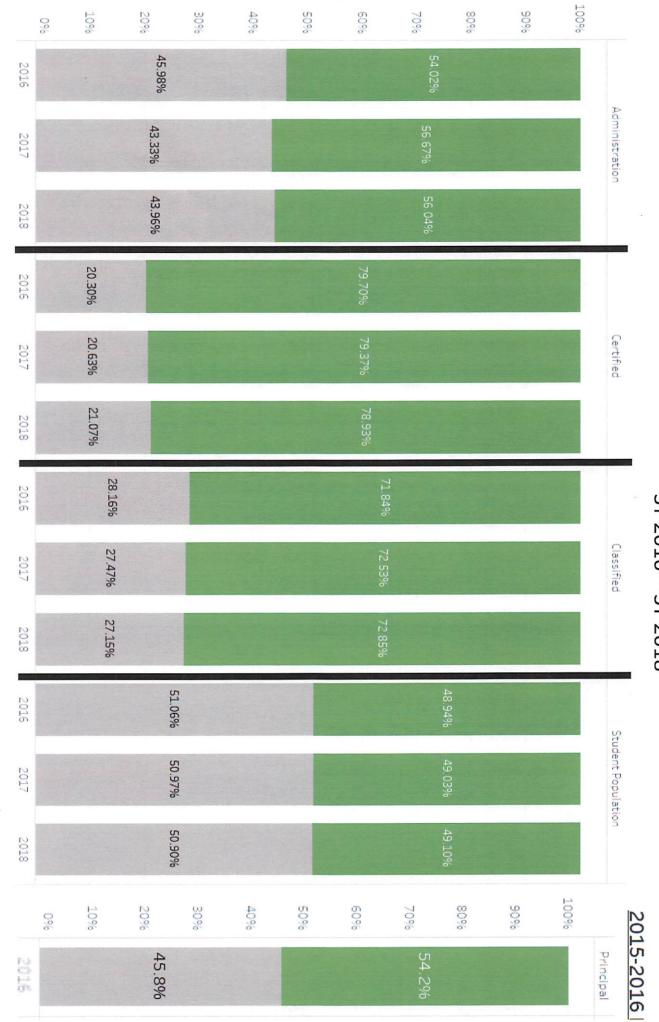
Student Demographic Trends SY 2013 – SY 2023

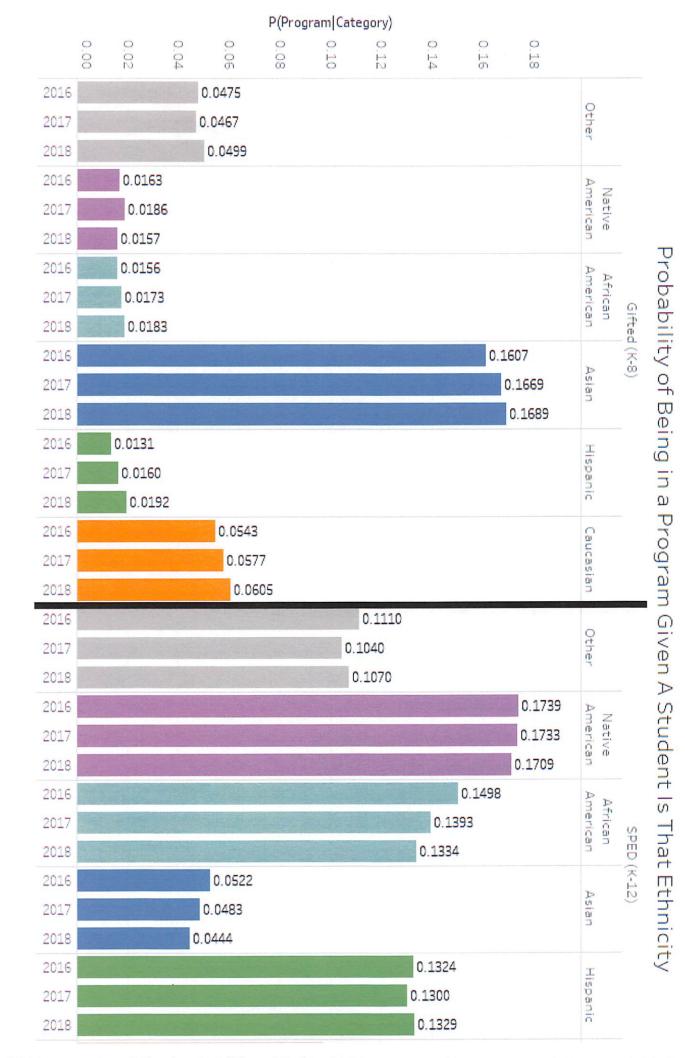
Selected Program Participation by Ethnicity



Frogram by Gender SY 2016 – SY 2018

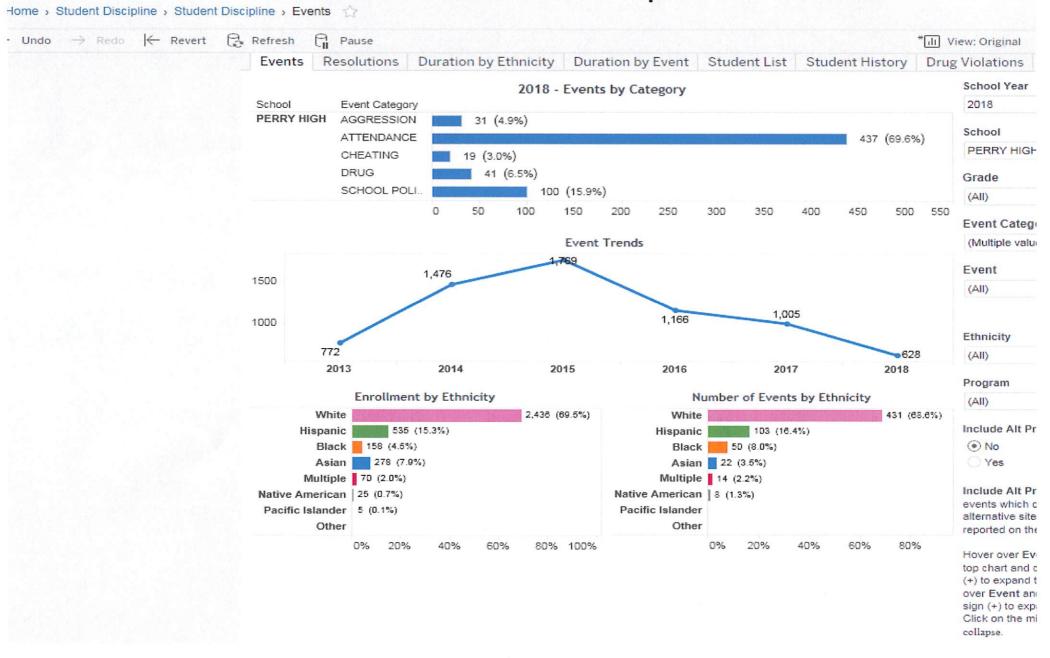




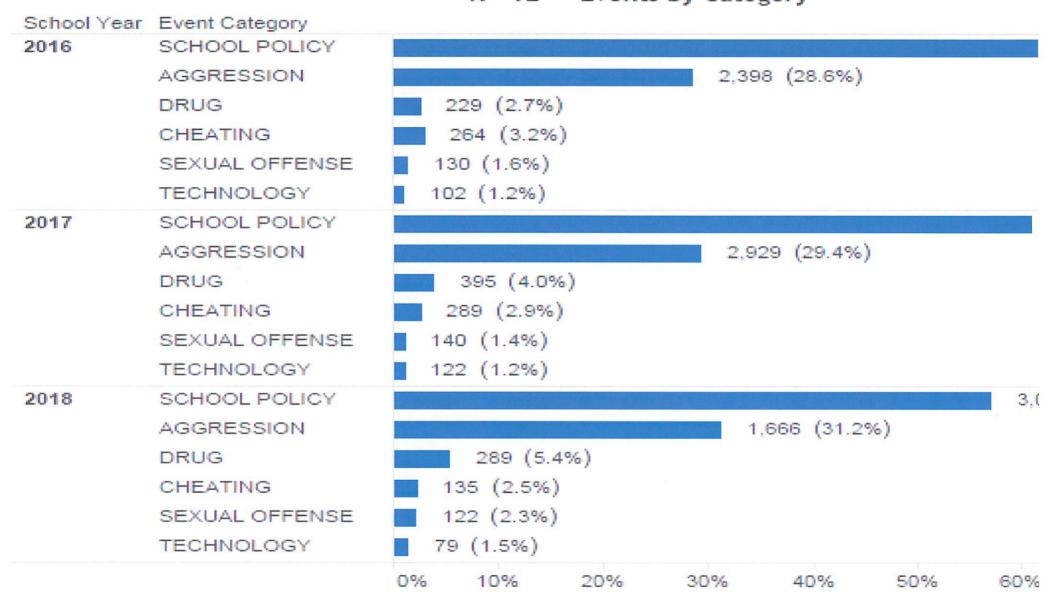

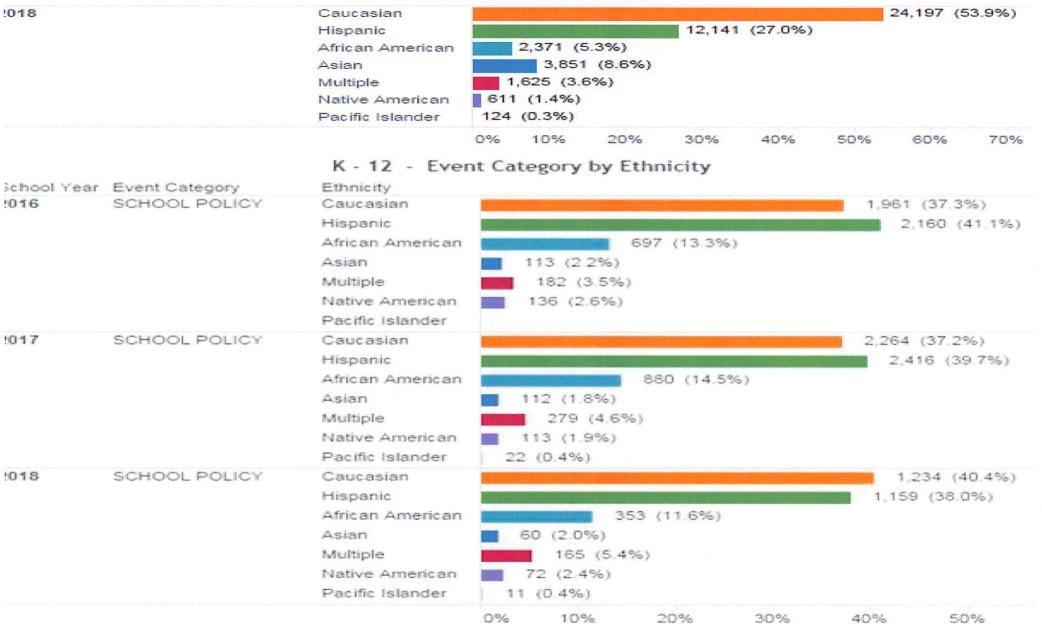

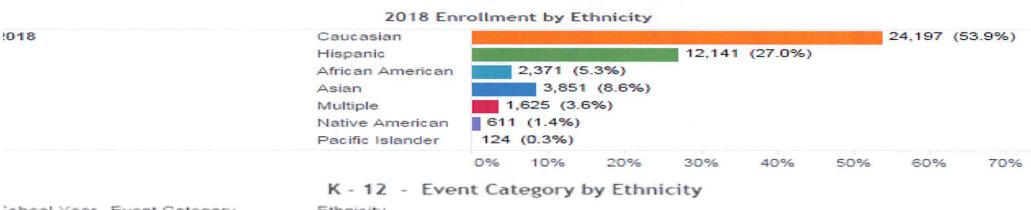


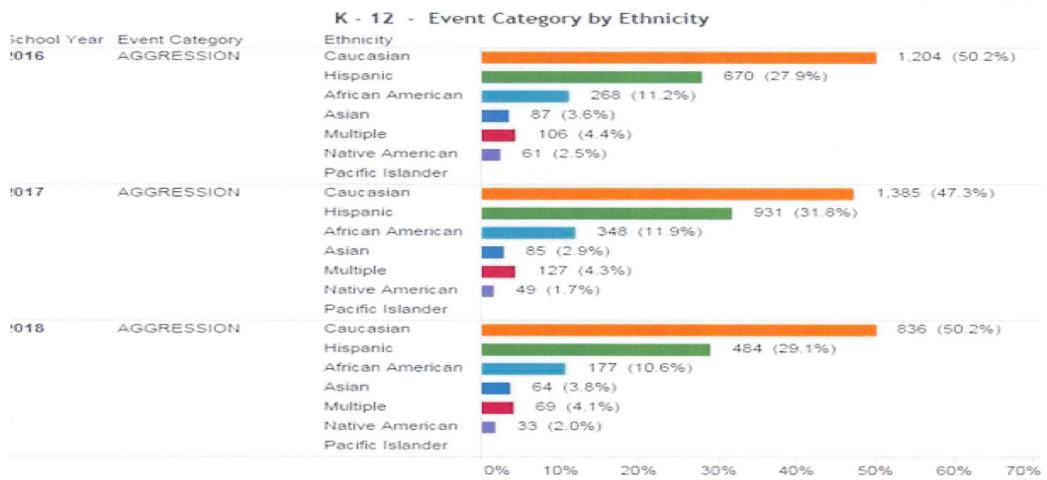
CUSD Discipline Data – School Policy Events by Ethnicity SY 2016 – SY 2018



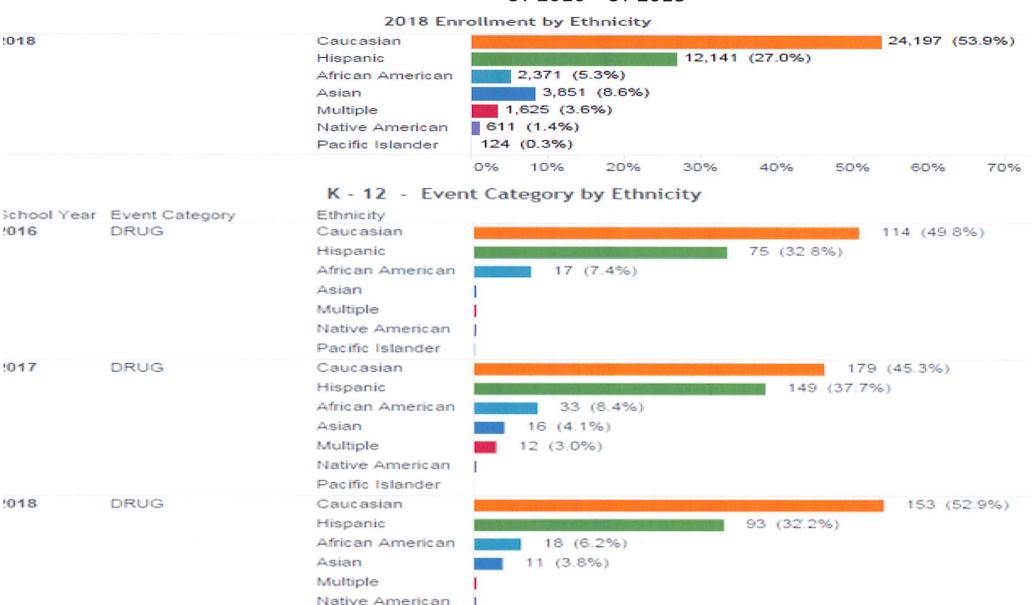

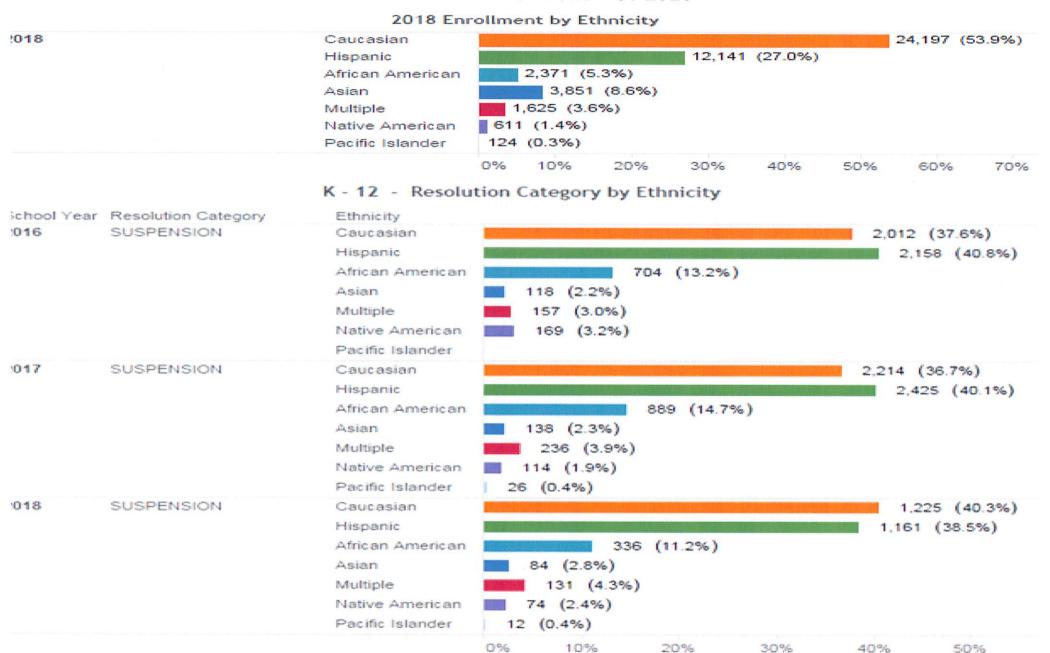

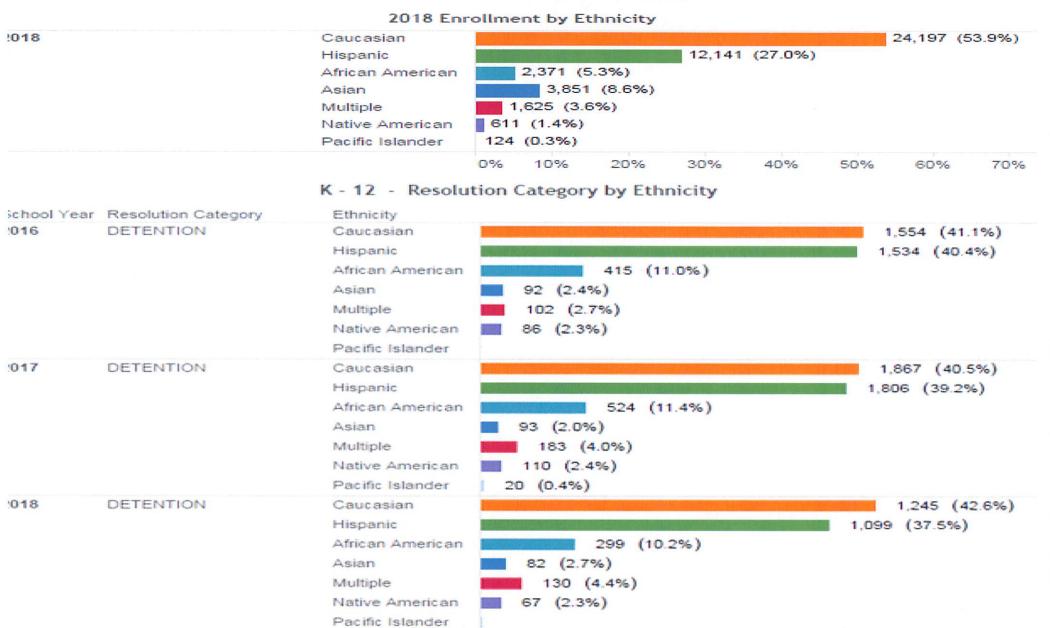

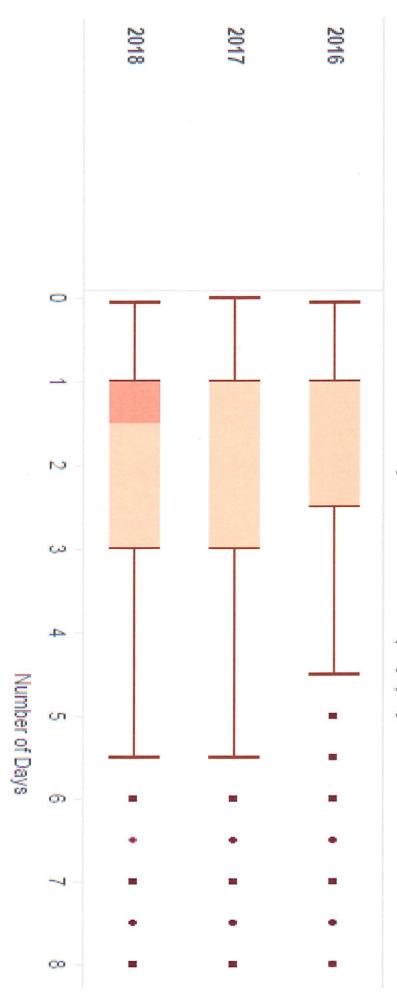

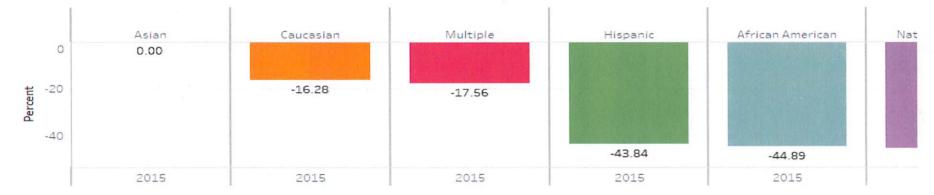

AzMERIT Mathematics - Achievement Gaps - SY 2015 – SY 201

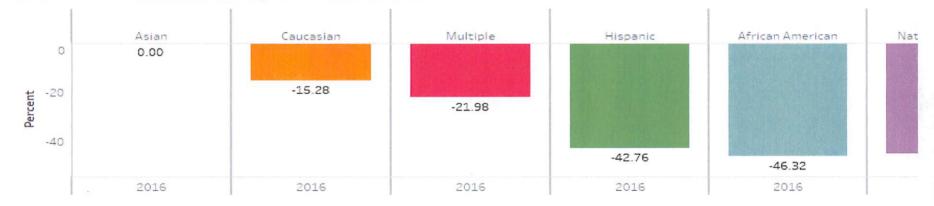

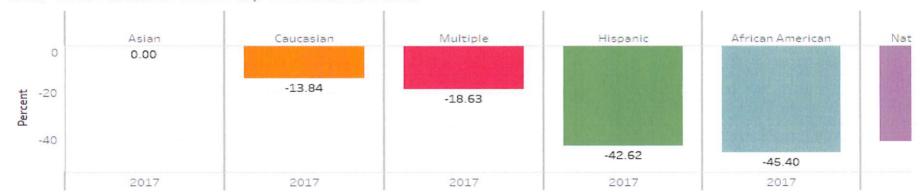
2015 CUSD AZ MERIT MATH Gap - Percent Proficient



2016 CUSD AZ MERIT MATH Gap - Percent Proficient



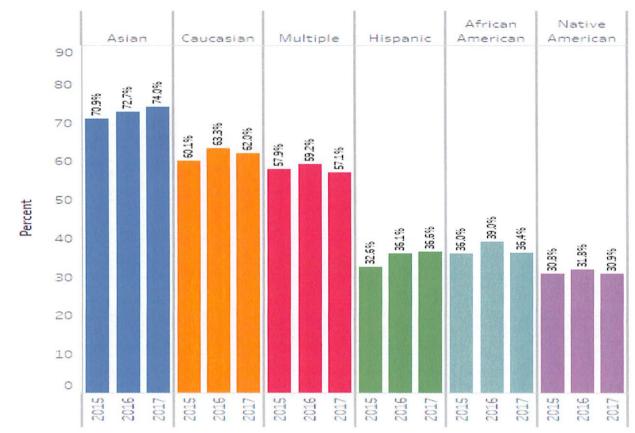

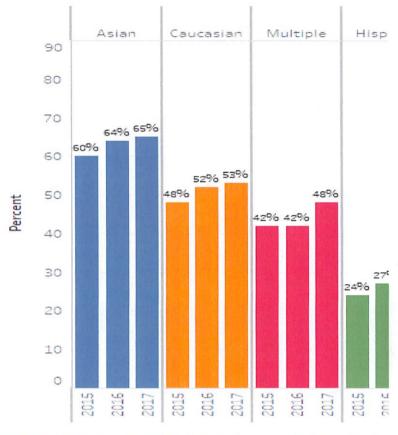

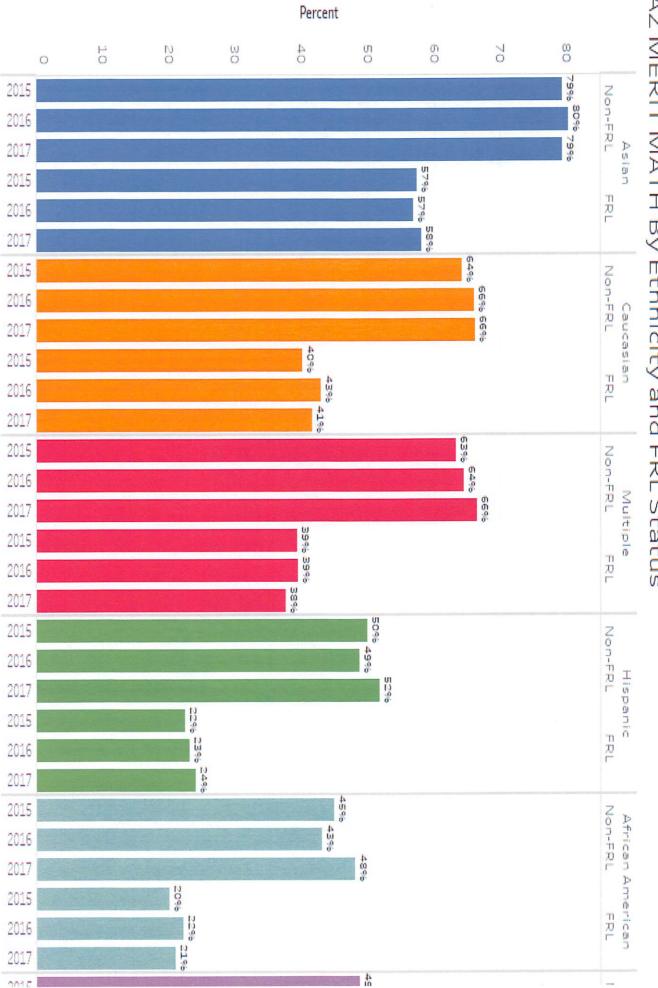

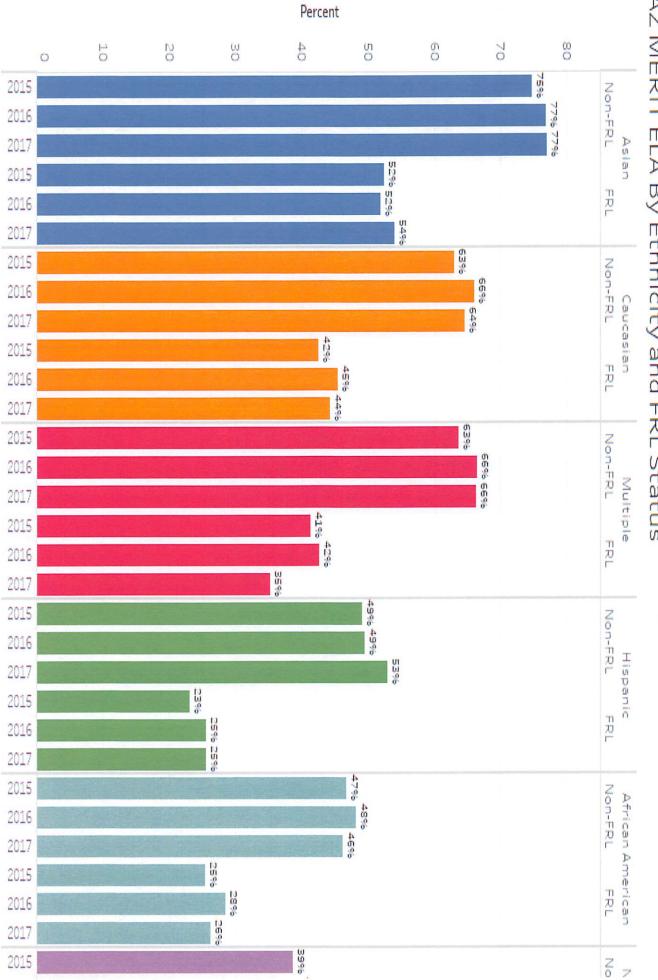

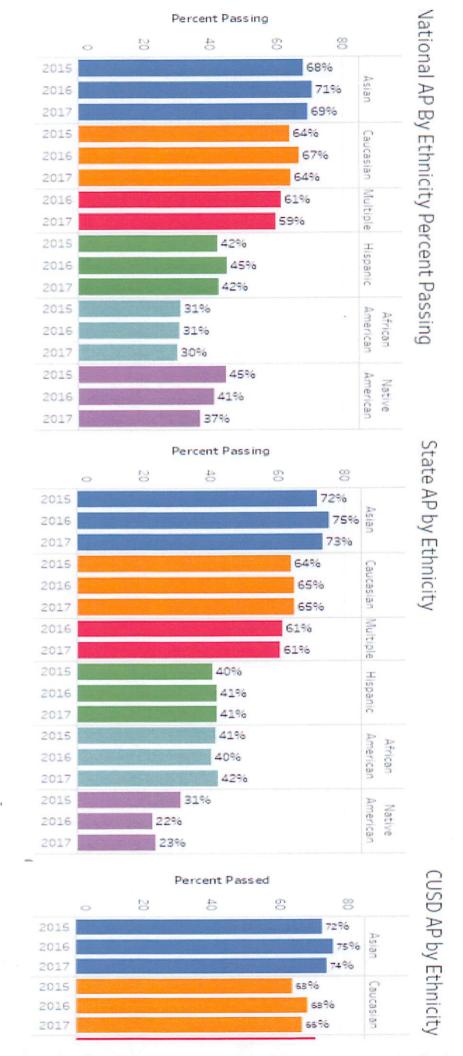

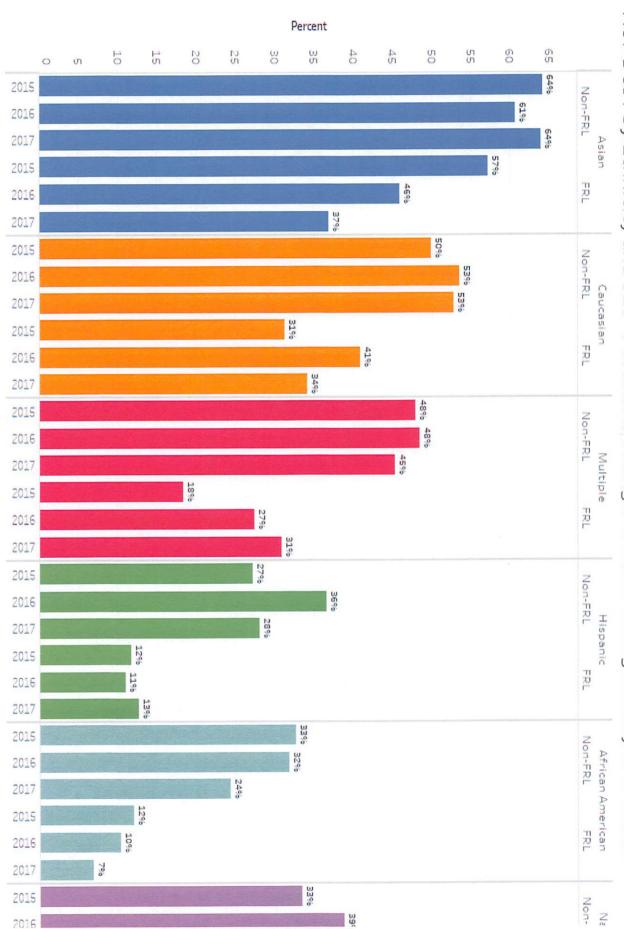


ACT-DCST 2017 GAPS - Percent Meeting 3 or More College Ready Benchmarks

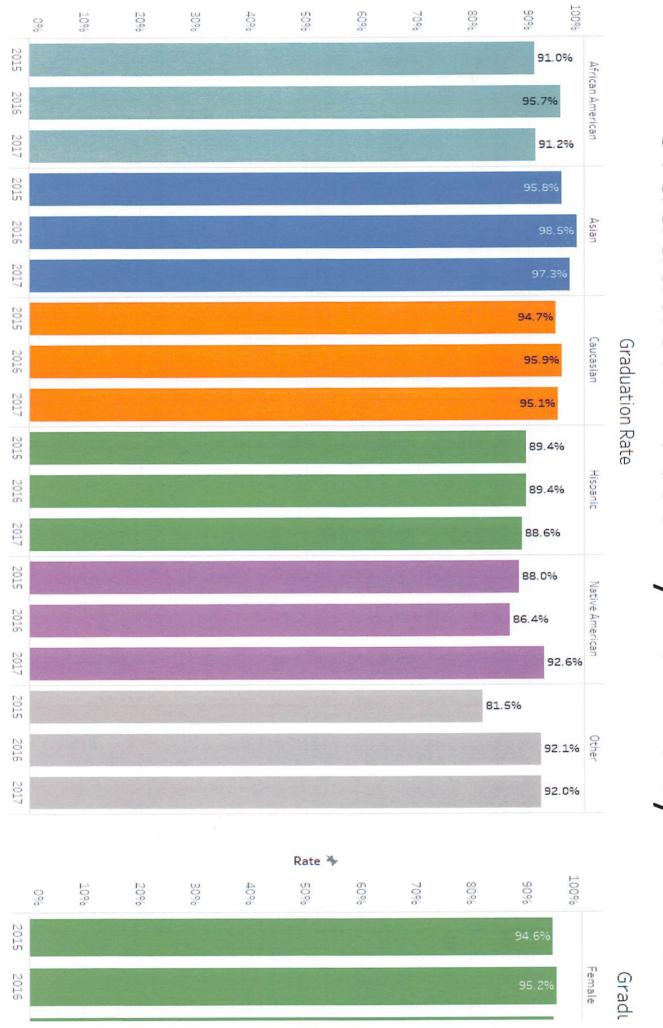
